- Return trip from Raleigh-NC State Fair boards at approximately 3:15pm and arrives back in Salisbury at approximately 5:41pm
- You will be responsible for expenses inside the fair such as ride tickets and food.
- NOTE: Feel free to bring food/drinks on the train to eat for breakfast - or - some food is available for purchase in the cafe car
- On the way back, feel free to bring food on the train to eat for supper...on the trip back coffee and water are complimentary with the price of your tickets. Can drinks and snacks are available for purchase from vending machines.


#### Companions in Christ Small Group Experience
